

Kentucky Voter Identification Requirements as of 7/15/20

Voters may confirm their identity by producing a document issued by:

- The state of Kentucky that contains both the voter's name **and** photograph
- The U.S. Government that contains both the voter's name **and** photograph
- The U.S. Department of Defense, a branch of the uniformed services, the Merchant Marines, or the KY National Guard that contains both the voter's name **and** photograph
- A public or private college, university, or postgraduate technical or professional school located within the United States that contains both the voter's name **and** photograph
- Any city government, county government, urban-county government, charter county government, consolidated local government, or unified local government, located in KY that contains both the voter's name **and** photograph

Voters who do not have one of the documents above may confirm their identity by doing one of the following:

- Complete an affidavit **and** present their Social Security Card
- Complete an affidavit **and** present a State Board of Election approved county ID card with the voter's name (Fayette County does not issue these)
- Complete an affidavit **and** present any ID card that contains **both** the voter's photograph and name
- Complete an affidavit **and** present a food stamp ID card, electronic benefit transfer card, or supplemental nutrition assistance card issued by Kentucky that shows the voter's name
- Complete an affidavit **and** present a credit or debit card in the voter's name

An election officer who personally knows a voter may confirm the voter's identity by completing an election officer affidavit
